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Welcome & Introductions	Carol and Mark welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending the meeting for the Practice Transformation Workgroup. Carol briefly reviewed the agenda and the 5-10 PTW Meeting Minutes. Rhonda moved to approve the 5-10, 2018 minutes, seconded by Mark Wakai. Motion passed.
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Practice Transformation Training & Orientation Feedback	GCACH’s Practice Transformation Navigator, Jenna, gave a presentation on her training over the past couple of weeks. Some major topics covered in her training included understanding a primary care practice and their challenges, the importance of engaged leadership, and her role in facilitating culture change with a primary care practice. Jenna has learned about data collection, management, presentation and most importantly, the skills to engage a practice and promote ownership. She shared her eagerness to start the transformation process and her enjoyment while learning the materials.
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Questions: What will your role be with the practices? Will practices ask for your help? When we talk about system transformation, is this like integrated managed care?

Answer: The Practice Transformation Navigators will go in to the practices that we contract with and become a partner or resource to the practice. OHSU will help us prioritize the CSA’s and point out those practices that are ready to do Practice Transformation. As we progress, we will continue to scale up.

Elevator Speech	Jenna and Wes read their elevator speeches to the group. The elevator speech will be used when Practice Facilitators enter practices, this is known as their “introductory” speech.
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From Silos to Transformation of Care  Discussion	Sam began her presentation by describing healthcare transformation, Patient-Centered Medical Homes (PCMH), and the eight change concepts. She then covered our four project areas highlighting the PCMH tools, Practice Transformation Approaches for each area and VBR. Sam’s presentation welcomed discussion and questions. Common questions asked were regarding how the concepts and workforce will tie into our project areas. There was a consensus that PTW members would like more detail on our project plan to have a better understanding of our approach.
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GCACH Potential Participating Providers Maps	Lauren introduced the maps she has been working on through the Maptitude Software. Each map had color-coded dots that represented potential participating providers by sector. The maps are organized by LHIN. Data was gathered from LOIs received.
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Highlights of CSA	Carol announced that we have received a total of 19 CSAs but are expecting several more to come in in the afternoon. OHSU will be providing GCACH with a low, medium and high prioritization list to identify providers that are ready for practice transformation.
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Adjournment	Carol ended the meeting by thanking all for attending. She noted that the next Practice Transformation Workgroup Meeting is set for June 14th.
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
