1. Page 6 - the general qualifications do not correspond with the General Qualifications on page 4. Specifically, what is #1 the Manager Plan referring to and I don't see similar language on page 4. Does response time refer to #3 on page 4 or does it refer to the organization submitting a timely response?

Please use the General Qualifications on Page 4.

Manager Plan – See A. General Qualifications #1. Provide information about your organization, size and location. Describe your methods for assuring conformance to a budget.

2. Is there a specific # of letters of intention from network partners that GCACH is looking for?

6. I didn't see any staffing requirements, just the scope of work and a max contract award amount. Am I just writing a proposal to meet the needs of 100 patients across all 3 counties for one year?

Yes, we are keeping this open ended to provide for innovative models. However, it is assumed that there will be care management resources devoted to this work.

7. Are there specific outcomes related to individuals with OUD you have in mind? And/or pay for reporting requirements? I'm trying to make sure it's data I'm capable of tracking and reporting. (pg.4)
